We have developed this report for distribution to the Board, our clients and our MBE/WBE Assistance Agencies as well as prospective bidders.

Our current program authority exceeds \$2 B in project development costs. Currently, we are under budget by 7.75%, representing \$160.5 MM in projected surplus.

This report provides a detailed snapshot of the PBC's LEED certified projects and metrics.

7. M/WBE Commitment Report Q1 2011 Construction Projects by Type (GC, JOC, Special Projects and CM at Risk)

Through Q1 2011, three contracts for General Construction (GC) projects valued at \$80,016,037.00 were awarded. Work orders on four Job Order Contract (JOC) projects valued at \$3,322,085.97 were awarded. Work orders for two Special projects valued at \$2,548,302.81 and trade packages for one CM at Risk contract with a value of \$5,793,700.00 have been awarded for a total value of \$91,680,125.78.

- MBE commitment in GC projects awarded through Q1 2011 was 27.97% valued at \$22,382,296.00
- MBE commitment in JOC projects awarded through Q1 2011 was 29.15% valued at \$968,315.59
- MBE commitment in Special projects awarded through Q1 2011 was 14.79% valued at \$376,878.00
- MBE commitment in CM at Risk projects awarded through Q1 2011 was 39.16% valued at \$2,268,675.00

8. M/WBE & EEO Compliance Report Q1 2011 Construction Project Completions

Through Q1 2011, three GC projects and one work order on a JOC contract reached completion for total value of \$15,521,906.22.

- MBE participation for 3 GC projects completed in 2011 was 29.42% valued at \$3,365,743.52
- MBE participation for 1 work order on a JOC project completed in 2011 was 33.24% valued at \$120,724.50 Total MBE participation achieved 29.54%
- WBE participation for the 3 GC projects completed in 2011 was 12.15% valued at \$1,390,066.42
 Total WBE participation achieved 11.78%

9. Construction Change Order, % Q1-2011 Report

The approved change order % for all categories is currently 2.3%. Including the projected change orders, the % for all categories is 3.0%. This falls below the industry standard change order percentage for new municipal and educational construction work of 3-5%.

10. Specialty Consultant Term Contracts Award and Commitment Report, 02/09/10 for Q1 2011

For the 1st quarter of 2011, twenty-three (23) task orders were issued to Specialty Consultant term contracts with a value of \$1,039,440.20. 62% of the dollars were awarded to MBE firms and 20% to WBE firms. 77% of the total was awarded to local firms.

Specialty Consultant Award and Commitment Report, 08/20/07 for Q1 2011

For the 1st quarter of 2011, 1 award valued at \$10,818.28 was made to 2007 Pre-Qualified Specialty Consultants to a non M/WBE firm. This method for procuring specialty consulting services is being phased out and replaced with task order assignments to the 2010 Board approved pre-qualified pool of specialty consultants' term contracts.



Market Conditions Report - High Schools (Current as of 3/18/11)



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




Market Conditions Report - Elementary Schools (Current as of 3/18/11)



Market Conditions Report - Police Stations (Current as of 3/18/11)










Market Conditions Report - Park District Fieldhouses (Current as of 3/18/11)



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

These rates are below the industry standard change order percentage for new municipal and educational construction work at 3-5%.

On February 9, 2010, the Public Building Commission (PBC) received Board approval to award sixty-six (66) term contracts to firms prequalified to provide consulting services in the following categories: Surveying, Commissioning, Environmental Categories A, B and C, Environmental Renovation / Demolition, Geotechnical, Traffic Study and Construction Inspection and Material Testing as follows:

A random lottery by category was conducted to establish the rotation of firms. As services are required, the rotation determines the firm to which a Request for Pricing is issued. Proposals are reviewed and evaluated for experience, expertise of staff, capacity, past performance, plan of action proposed and pricing. Upon approval, PBC staff issues a task order against the successful firm's term contract.

On March 8, 2011, the PBC received Board approval to supplement the existing pool of sixty-six (66) pre-qualified Specialty Consultants through the addition of thirty-one (31) new firms providing the same category of services as follows:

The PBC is currently in the process of obtaining executed Agreements from the recently added firms. As each Agreement is executed, the firms will be added to the rotation making them available to participate in Request for Pricing exercises discussed above.

In the 1st quarter of 2011, twenty-three (23) task orders valuing \$1,039,440.20 were issued against the Specialty Consultant term contracts. Of that total dollar value, 62% of the dollars were issued to MBE firms and 20% to WBE firms.

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In the first quarter of 2011, contracts were awarded to consulting firms pre-qualified to provide Surveying, Commissioning, Environmental and Construction Inspection and Material Testing services. These awards were made in accordance to the resolution passed by the Board in August 2007 which granted the Executive Director authority to contract for those Specialty Services to a pre-qualified pool of consultants as follows:

Surveying – \$50,000 per award
Phase I Environmental - \$50,000 per award
Phase II Environmental - \$250,000 per award
Environmental Design - \$50,000 per award
Commissioning - \$125,000 per award
Construction Material Testing - \$150,000 per award

As these services are required, a scope is developed by PBC staff and a request for proposal is sent via e-mail by PBC Procurement to all pre-qualified consultants in that specialty. Although pricing is a critical facet for evaluation, all submitted proposals are also evaluated for experience, expertise of staff, capacity, past performance and plan of action proposed.

In the 1st quarter of 2011, one award valued at \$10,818.28 was made to 2007 Pre-Qualified consultants. Of that total dollar value, 0% of the dollars was awarded to MBE firms and 0% to WBE firms.

This method for procuring specialty consulting services is being phased out and replaced with task order assignments to the 2010 Board approved pre-qualified pool of specialty consultants' term contracts.
