Additional Service Proposal for LEED-NC v2.1 'Silver' Certification Consulting Services

### Dear Jim:

In response to your recent request, Henneman Engineering (Henneman) is pleased to provide the subject additional service proposal. We feel that the Henneman Team is exceptionally qualified to perform this work and has the available resources to do so successfully.

As you know, Henneman was awarded LEED consulting services contracts for the subject projects in June, 2005. It has been our mutual understanding that the current contract calls for Henneman to provide services to help direct the respective project teams on design, construction, and review efforts and documentation for application to the US Green Building Council for the purpose of LEED-NCv2.1 'Basic' certification (achievement of at least 26 credits).

Soon after the contract start date, some lack of mutual clarity arose regarding which level of LEED certification (Basic, Silver, Gold, or Platinum) would be targeted for these projects. Since Henneman's contract was predicated on targeting 'basic' LEED certification, Henneman requested, and received direction on the subject from the PBCC's original project manger, Christian McNamee, (in an email to Henneman's project manager, Alex Nikolich, dated August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2005). A copy of this e-mail is included as Attachment A

Henneman's understanding of the clear direction communicated by the PBCC in Attachment A, was to target the LEED 'silver' required number of credits (33). However should any of the projects demonstrate any inability to meet the targeted credits, the PBCC would accept 'basic' certification (at least 26 credits) in order to meet the contracted requirement. This is the same strategy that Henneman has successfully implemented with respect to our LEED consulting services for the Oriole Park (certified Basic), Logan Square (certified Silver), Bucktown/Wicker Park (certified Basic), Avalon (Basic anticipated), and Vodak East Side (Basic anticipated) branch libraries for the PBCC. The direction describing the goal for the projects was consistent with the (then) current Chicago Standard document (included as Attachment B), which was published in June of 2004 and required a minimum of 26 LEED credits for all of Chicago's new municipal buildings, including the subject projects.

With receipt of the PBCC's most recent communication on the subject matter (included as Attachment C), we understand that a more aggressive LEED goal has been established and that LEED-NC 'Silver' certification (at least 33 credits) will be the minimum requirement for the subject projects. Due to the ongoing discussions related to the likelihood of this new requirement being implemented for these projects, Henneman has already (when necessary in order to preserve even the possibility of potentially achieving a Silver certification) performed some of the feasibility & team consultation activities necessary in support of this new goal.

## C. SCOPE:

In light of the PBCC's new goal of LEED-NC silver certification for the subject projects, we present the following proposal of additional activities which are to be accomplished, by Henneman, for each of the (4) projects, in order to fulfill the PBCC's wish to ensure LEED silver certification.

LEED-NC v2.1 Silver Additional Services Summary: Henneman shall identify the 'Core' credits (33) for each of the four fire station projects. Upon completion, Henneman shall review & identify feasibility for certain, currently targeted & non-targeted LEED credits for inclusion in a 'Menu' of feasible credits for the PBCC to select from. Henneman shall meet with the PBCC in order to assist in the selection of an appropriate menu of credits for each project targeting at least 37 in order to maximize the probability of achieving the required 33 credits needed for LEED silver certification. Henneman shall add the selected menu credits to each project's LEED Checklist, and provide the project teams with the appropriate LEED Silver Actions List. Henneman shall, then, help verify the appropriate actions are taken with respect to the LEED Silver Actions List in a manner consistent with the original contract.

Henneman's fee (TBD) for these additional services (TBD) shall be the same irrespective of which alternate credits are selected by the PBCC, so long as the sum total of targeted credits does not exceed 37 for each project. A/E team and GC fee costs may vary with respect to which alternate credits are selected to fulfill the 37 credit target goal for each respective project. These shall be determined by each A/E & CG on a case-by-case basis once the PBCC has had the opportunity to deliberate, and direct credit selections.

Henneman is awaiting a written (email is OK) response from the PBCC on whether or not LEED 'silver' (33 points certified, minimum) is to be a requirement for the CFD Engine Companies 18, 70, 109, & 121 projects. Upon

receipt of a 'silver' direction, Henneman shall investigate & author an additional service proposal to complete the required LEED work, and assist the PBCC in the selection of appropriate credits.

We (Henneman) request a clarification to the above, at the soonest possible convenience as this issue is long outstanding, and has become an extremely time-sensitive due to the various advanced stages of each project's respective progress.

I talked to Alex this morning. They are requesting from PBC something in writing that shows that PBC is looking to achieve silver certification at the 4 fire stations. Can you send Alex an email that says PBC would like to ACHIEVE silver certification?

We discussed that their proposal will state they will be targeting a minimum of 37 points (33 is minimum to achieve silver). Currently they are targeting 33 points only.

Alex will also provide by station a "menu" of points to pursue, since some points are more expensive than others. HEI's cost will be the same but there may be additional AOR or GC costs associated with the additional points. Please note that HEI does not intend to provide any sort of "deliverable" such as the photometric study that is required for the light pollution credit - they will expect the EOR to provide that.

We are pleased to submit our revised fee proposal to continue the Chicago Children's Advocacy Center project through the completion of Contract Closeout. Our current contract authorizes us to complete Programming and Schematic Design phases for a lump sum fee of \$400,000.00. We propose completing Design Development phase, Contract Document phase, Bidding Phase, Contract Administration Phase, and Contract Closeout for a total additional fee of \$1,115,000.00. This revised fee includes the services of a LEED Consultant and is based upon obtaining a basic LEED Certification.

We also propose providing Contingent Additional Services for enhanced on-site observation during construction phase to be billed at 2.5 x Personnel Salary for a not to exceed fee of \$200,000.

We understand that construction funding for the project has currently not been secured and that the project may be put on hold at the completion of Contract Documents,

As requested, we have obtained a fee proposal for the work required to obtain a basic LEED Certification, a LEED Sliver Certification, a LEED Gold Certification, and a LEED Platinum Certification. If the PBC elects to pursue a LEED rating above the basic certification level our fee will need to be increased as follows:

1. The fee to obtain a LEED Silver Certification is an increase of \$2,000.00 to the base fee for a total lump sum fee of \$1,117,000.00.

2. The fee to obtain a LEED Gold Certification is an increase of \$6,000.00 to the base fee for a total lump sum fee of \$1,121,000.00.

3. The fee to obtain a LEED Platinum Certification is an increase of \$17,000.00 to the base fee for a total lump sum fee of \$1,132,000.00.
